



Printing Instructions

I recommend using "Cover Stock" or lightweight cardstock paper {67 lb}, especially since this needs to be printed double-sided.

If you have a Double-Sided Printer: 1. Select: Print Range/From > pages **2 to 5** 2. Select: Layout > Two-Sided > "Short-Edge Binding" {This will ensure all the pages are right side up!} 3. Print!

Otherwise: Print pages 2 & 4, then print pages 3 & 5 on reverse side -OR- print each page one at a time (this booklet will not "make sense" unless it is printed on both sides and folded up.)





The Tower




They said to each other, "Come, let's make bricks and bake them thoroughly." They used brick instead of stone, and tar for mortar.



"That is why it was called Babel – because there the Lord confused the language of the whole world."


Genesis 11:9
